I met the Los Angeles Challenge while attending St. Mary's Academy 2014-2018 and they supported me tremendously during the college application process in addition to tuition at St. Mary's Academy. During the application process LAC helped me prepare for my SAT and proofread my personal statement, this helped me curate a better personal statement as I was able to produce more articulate ideas. I was also able to accomplish graduating from high school with a Magna Cum Laude honor and awards in English, Religion, and several other academic awards. As an LAC student I accomplished applying and being accepted by several universities and becoming a college freshman.

When my acceptance letters arrived, LAC helped me look through them and pick the school that best fits my interests and needs, including an institution that embraced diversity and encouraged me to pursue my interests such as Psychology and English. LAC helped me pick by doing research on each school with me and showing me some how to do research on my own including looking at the mission statement of school's, exploring the services they offer student's, and what programs they had to help minorities.
